2011 GEORGIA GOLDEN OLYMPICS INFORMATION

The 2011 Georgia Golden Olympics Committee extends a personal invitation to you to attend an exciting event. ALL MEN and WOMEN, 50 and OVER, are invited to participate in the Georgia Golden Olympics on September 21-24, 2011 (Wednesday through Saturday) in Warner Robins, GA, hosted by the Warner Robins Recreation Department.

PURPOSE

By providing the opportunity to participate in a social, competitive, recreational, and athletic event, the Golden Olympics:

- Creates an awareness of the abilities and capabilities of older adults.
- ♦ Helps to maintain and improve health and wellness.
- ◆ Promotes an interest in lifetime sports, recreation and physical activity.

AGE/CATEGORY

AGE:

- Determined by participant's age as of December 31, 2011.
- All individual national qualifying events will be held in 5 year age brackets (50-54, 55-59, 60-64, 65-69, 70-74, 75-79, 80-84, 85-89, 90+): archery, badminton, bowling, cycling, field events, golf, horseshoe tournament, race walk events, road races, racquetball, shuffleboard, swimming, table tennis, tennis, and track events.
- ◆ All non-national qualifying events will be held in four age categories (50-59, 60-69, 70-79, 80+) for men and women: basketball throw, billiards, checkers, clock golf, frisbee throw, football throw, horse shoe toss, softball throw, ½ mile walk, 1500M walk, 5K walk and wheelchair race.
- ♦ Team sports will be held in the following age categories. 50+, 55+, 60+, 65+, 70+, 75+. Three on three basket-ball will have an 80+ division. Age division is determined by the youngest player on team as of December 31, 2011.
- ◆ Age division for doubles and mixed doubles is determined by the youngest partner on December 31, 2011.

CATEGORY:

 Sitting and standing. (Note: Sitting category is designed for those participants whose physical mobility is dependent upon supportive devices such as wheelchairs or walkers.)

REGISTRATION AND TOURNAMENT FEES

◆ Registration fee of \$35 if registered by August 1, 2011 (Late Registration: \$70.00 after August 1, 2011 until August 15 only) entitles participant to enter three (3) events of their choice with no time conflicts. A \$6.00 fee per event is charged for each additional event over three. Archery, bowling, cycling, golf, tennis and softball have additional fees. The Archery fee is \$10.00, the Bowling fee is \$7.50 per event, the Cycling fee is \$10.00, the Golf fee is \$25.00 which includes cart and green fees, the Tennis fee is \$5.00, and the softball tournament fee is \$50 per team. This fee covers your registration expenses only. It does not entitle participants to a T-shirt. Shirts are given only to

those who participate in an event.

◆ <u>FEES ARE NON REFUNDABLE FOR ANY REASON</u> AFTER AUGUST 30, 2011

REGISTRATIONS

◆ The enclosed registration form must be completed and mailed with proper fee and age verification by August 1, 2011 (must be postmarked by August 1). Late registrations will be accepted until August 15 with an additional fee. No registrations will be accepted after this date. The liability waiver on the Registration form must be signed and dated by the applicant. Incomplete registrations will be returned but may be resubmitted within five days of notification. (Late fee is charged for registrations post marked after August 1, 2011 through August 15, 2011).

COMBINED/CANCELED EVENTS:

♦ Olympic officials reserve the right to combine age groups or cancel events with insufficient numbers registered.

FORFEIT TIME:

♦ Athletes forfeit the right to participate if not present at an event 15 minutes prior to start for roll call.

PROOF OF AGE

- ◆ Proof of age is required if you HAVE NOT participated in the Georgia Golden Olympics since 1993.
- ♦Acceptable proof of age includes copy of an ID such as driver's license, birth certificate, passport, military record.
- ◆ Registrations without acceptable proof of age will be returned and will delay the registration process.

PARTICIPATION

- ◆ Participation entitles individual to T-Shirt, admission to awards dinner, lunch on Saturday and medal for 1st, 2nd, or 3rd place winners. Shirts are given to participating athletes only.
- ♦Athletes are responsible for knowing the rules, regulations, physical requirements and abilities needed for the event.

EVENT CHANGES/ADDITIONS/NOTES

- Only (5) **swimming** events allowed.
- Only two (2) **tennis** events allowed.
- Doubles and mixed doubles athletes must provide their own partner and each athlete must register.
- **Team Managers** for **softball** and **basketball** should request a roster and team registration form from the GGO office (770-867-3603) or print from the website:

www.georgiagoldenolympics.org

Manager should submit team fee. Each player must register individually and list manager name, phone number and team name on form.

- Athletes may not compete in both Horseshoe Tournament and Horseshoe Toss.
- Race walkers may not compete in walking events and vice versa.
- Race walkers, runners, 1500M and 5K walkers may not compete in the ½ mile walk.
- Awards will be given at the completion of the events.
- The Celebration/ Parade of Athletes will be held on Thursday evening before the athlete reception. There will not be a closing ceremony on Saturday.

RULES AND POLICIES

- ♦ All events are governed by the National Governing Board rules for each event. Exceptions are noted in the Georgia Golden Olympics Rule Book. A copy of the Georgia Rule Book can be ordered for \$6.00 from: GGO Rules, PO Box 958, Winder, GA 30680.
- ♦ During an event all appeals for official interpretation shall be made to the Event Director for that specific event. If the Event Director needs assistance or a controversy occurs, the Rules Committee will render a final decision. *Appeals must be filed immediately or the right to appeal is forfeited.*

SCHEDULE CONFLICTS

♦ Due to the number of events, there are time frames when more than one event is scheduled. Athletes will be allowed to register in only one event per time frame unless otherwise noted. It is the athlete's responsibility to check for time conflicts. Registrations with schedule conflicts will be returned or GGO staff will make the event choice.

RAIN PLAN

♦ In case of inclement weather, unusual or extenuating circumstances, Georgia Golden Olympics officials reserve the right to cancel or postpone events to a different time than scheduled.

FOOD/FUN/AWARDS DINNER

- ◆Game Night-Join us for Wii Bowling and lots of other games on Wednesday evening at the Wellston Center at 6:00 pm. Bring your favorite snack to share and have some fun.
- ♦ On Friday evening from 6:30 pm all athletes are invited to the Awards Dinner at the Wellston Center, 155 Maple Street. The evening will include a delicious meal, awards presentations, gift basket raffle, music and dancing. The theme for the evening will be "Fiesta". Dress in your southwest attire and come party, meet, mingle, dance and have fun. Awards will be given for the most fitting attire.
